

THURSDAY MEN'S LEAGUE

Format: We will be running a different event each week and the events are stated in the schedule. All the events will be based on at least four men playing each week. Your team will need to have at least four players each week to compete for the prizes. If you have only three show up, you can still play for hole events, but can not compete for the weekly event. Having five men will allow your team to throw out at least one score each week depending on the event. This will give your team a better chance of winning. Hole events will be on the course every week. Scores will be turned into the bar after golf. PLEASE PUT FIRST AND LAST NAMES ON ALL SCORE CARDS.

BLIND BOGEY—The blind bogey is a score between 35-50 that the golf shop will choose each week. You can adjust your score before you play by giving us a number that will subtract off your score to get you between 35 and 50. Example: If I think I am going to shoot 55 I would tell the golf shop I want a minus 12 or something close. This will get me in the middle of the range and give me a good chance to win. If my adjusted score is the score that the golf shop draws for that week, I win. All winners will divide the money for that week, paid in Wisconsin River Golf Club credit, good on pro shop merchandise or WRGC beverages from the bar or pro shop. Any other questions please ask the golf shop. The cost each week is \$2

Rain Outs – 33% of all players must be here for the flag events to be paid out – 50% of all teams must play for team competition to be held. Weekly Prizes – All winnings will be paid out with Wisconsin River Golf Club credit. This credit can be used on pro shop merchandise, or WRGC beverages from the bar or pro shop. Ask the bar or pro shop staff how to redeem.

5-Somes – 5-somes are standard for the Thursday Men's League in 2022. There will be no time that more than 5 people will be permitted. Please keep up to the group ahead of you. Slow play will not be tolerated.

Dues: \$45 Per Person – Does not include the Closing Banquet.

Substitutes: 2022 sub fee - \$45 Per Person

SUB RULES:

1st Option: You can have a paid sub. This sub will pay their \$45 league fee and this will allow them to compete for any team and for the hole events. They are also eligible to win prize certificates.

2nd Option: If you are going to be short on golfers you can invite someone to play that is not in the league. Each week you need at least 4 golfers to qualify for the team event. This year as long as you have enough paid league members to play in the team event (ex. 2 players for two low nets) you can meet your golfer quota with non-league people. If the team were to win credit, the non-league people would not receive any prize money. A non-league sub is not eligible for hole events.
