

SENIOR LEAGUE

Format: We will be running a different event each week and the events are stated in the schedule. All the events will be based on at least three people playing each week. Your team will need to have at least three players each week to compete for the prizes. If you have only two show up, you can still play for hole events, but can't compete for the weekly event. Having four people will allow your team to throw out at least one score each week depending on the event. This will give your team a better chance of winning. Hole events will be on the course every week. Scores will be turned in to the bar after golf.

LEAGUE RULES AND EVENTS

Chip-In's—Each week we will have a chip-in pot that you can participate in. Cost is \$.50

Rain Outs – 33% of all players must be here for the flag events to be paid out – 50% of all teams must play for team competition to be held.

Weekly Payout— All winnings will be paid out with Wisconsin River Golf Club credit. This credit can be used on pro shop merchandise or beverages from the WRGC bar or pro shop.

4-Somes – 4-somes are standard for the Tuesday Senior League. There will be no time that more than 4 people will be permitted. Please keep up to the group ahead of you.

Dues: \$45 Per Person – Does not include the Closing Banquet.

Substitutes: 2023 sub fee - \$45 Per Person

SUB RULES

1st Option: You can have a paid sub. This sub will pay their \$45 league fee and this will allow them to compete for any team and for the hole events. They are also eligible to win prize credit.

2nd Option: If you are going to be short on golfers you can invite someone to play that is not in the league. Each week you need at least 3 golfers to qualify for the team event. This year as long as you have enough paid league members to play in the team event (ex. 2 players for two low nets) you can meet your golfer quota with non-league people. If the team were to win credit, the non-league people would not receive any prize money. A non-league sub is not eligible for hole events.
