

THURSDAY MEN'S LEAGUE

Format: We will be running a different event each week and the events are stated in the schedule. All the events will be based on at least four men playing each week. Your team will need to have at least four players each week to compete for the prizes. If you have only three show up, you can still play for hole events, but can't compete for the weekly event. Having five men will allow your team to throw out at least one score each week depending on the event. This will give your team a better chance of winning. Hole events will be on the course every week. Scores will be turned in to the bar after golf. PLEASE PUT FIRST AND LAST NAMES ON ALL SCORE CARDS.

BLIND BOGEY—The blind bogey is a number between 35-50 that the golf shop will choose each week. When you check in for golf you will give us a number to add to or subtract from your score. **Example: I might tell the golf shop I want minus 12. I then go play my round and turn in my scorecard. I shot 55. So my blind bogey number is $55-12 = 43$. If the golf shop pulls 43 I win part of the blind bogey pot.** All winners will divide the money for that week, paid in Wisconsin River Golf Club credit, good on pro shop merchandise, food or beverages from the bar or pro shop. Any other questions please ask the golf shop.

The cost each week is \$2.

Rain Outs – 33% of all players must be here for the flag events to be paid out – 50% of all teams must play for team competition to be held.

Weekly Prizes – All winnings will be paid out with Wisconsin River Golf Club credit. This credit can be used on pro shop merchandise, food or beverages from the bar or pro shop. Ask the bar or pro shop staff how to redeem.

5-Somes – 5-somes are standard for the Thursday Men's League in 2026. There will be no time that more than 5 people will be permitted. Please keep up to the group ahead of you.

Dues: \$50 Per Person – Does not include the Closing Banquet.

Substitutes: 2026 sub fee - \$50 Per Person

SUB RULES

1st Option: You can have a paid sub. This sub will pay their \$50 league fee and this will allow them to compete for any team and for the hole events. They are also eligible to win prize credit.

2nd Option: If you are going to be short on golfers you can invite someone to play that is not in the league. Each week you need at least 4 golfers to qualify for the team event. This year as long as you have enough paid league members to play in the team event (ex. 2 players for two low nets) you can meet your golfer quota with non-league people. If the team were to win credit, the non-league people would not receive any prize money. A non-league sub is not eligible for hole events.
